RULES TO BE OBSERVED BY THE SORTERS.

- 1. The bags must be properly packed in the pouch.
- 2. The net must be drawn up quickly after passing the standards.
- 3. See that the pouch is duly detached from the arm, and that the arm returns to its upright position.
- 4. Should a failure occur, the arm must be drawn in by the check cord.
- 5. Should the traductor spring break, the pouch should be eased down into working position by the check cord.
- 6. If the springs are weak, or a strong wind is blowing, tie a piece of string once round the lid.
- 7. The receiving net must not be raised until all the standards are passed at stations where more than one set are fitted. This does not apply to a station where there is a standard at both ends of the platform, as on no account must a net be in working position when passing through a station.

Note.—The ordinary working is here shown. The number of pouches despatched and received may vary occasionally.
